The Role

The role of a District Commissioner is very rewarding and is an opportunity to develop yourself and others and meet young people whose lives have been positively changed by Scouting. For Meon Valley, the District Commissioner or District Commissioner Team, will be required to inspire, encourage and work with adult volunteers to develop and implement a strategic vision for Scouting, whilst motivating Scout Groups to grow and deliver exciting and adventurous activities and increase access to Scouting for those young people currently unable to join groups. This is a flexible role and is open to role share within a small team. The format of the team can be decided between its members with some guidance from Headquarters. These roles do not necessarily need to be filled by current adult volunteers
