- Liaise with medical staff to ensure activities are provided to patients in an appropriate manner, and obtain regular feedback from the head of the Youth and play team/matron
- Ensure that activities follow, as closely as possible, the scouting curriculum and offer and exciting challenge to young people
- Liaise with the HSIH manager and coordinators of other groups within HSIH in planning the activities and obtaining materials
- Work with the HSIH manager to expand the activities as funds and facilities allow
- Assist the HSIH manager in raising funds to fund the activities
