- Discover the remarkable story of the Rover Scout Units in German POW camps during WW2, and how Scouting spirit endured behind the wire.
- Learn new knots with members of the experienced 'The International Knotting Guild'.
- Pick up fresh bushcraft skills, from simple techniques to clever campcraft.
- See some of the largest collection of Scout badges in the UK, spanning decades of Scouting history.
  - Help make rope using traditional methods.
  - Create your own Scout badge to take home.
- Browse old stock from the Arrow District Scout Shop, with treasures from years gone by.
  - Brand your own piece of leather, a classic Scouting craft.
- Find out who was in Scouting in Hampshire in 1960, with records from the era.
- Learn about the Hampshire Scout Leaders who gave their lives in WW1 and WW2 and the legacy they left behind.
  - Enjoy refreshments from "Spam and Roll"
